OUR LADY OF ASSUMPTION CATHEDRAL SUMMER CONCERT SERIES BEGINS ALONG WITH GUIDED TOURS

Come and visit Our Lady of the Assumption Cathedral "Acadian Monument" throughout the summer and also attend the two concerts during July and August.

Concert: Monday August 2, 8 pm brings an evening of Bach; Journey through the essence of Music which will be performed by Benjamin Allard, France, organist.



Guided Tours: The guided tours will be every Wednesday, Thursday and Friday until August 27 10:00am to 3:00pm daily or by request 857-0082. Three evening visits have been scheduled on Thursday August 5, Thursday August 12 and Thursday August 19 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm.

The tours of the Cathedral will have visitors exploring Acadian history through sculpted columns and through the personalities depicted in the stain glass windows. Visitors will also see the prie-Dieu chair used by Pope John Paul II preserved in the Archbishop Melanson chapel and the Casavant organ containing 5176 pipes ranging from 2cm to 10m in height



The **Youth Entrepreneurship Camp** is a 5-day camp that teaches youth about starting their own business. The idea is to explore entrepreneurship while promoting innovation and skill development. Campers will learn how to develop an idea, organize that idea into a business plan, how to make their products, and sell them in an actual marketplace at the end of the week.

Market: in front of Moncton City Hall on Friday August 13th from 10am-1pm Campers will receive a start up loan of \$20 which will be used to purchase all of the materials they will need. When the camp has concluded after the marketplace, students will pay back the \$20 and keep everything else as profit! **DON'T WORRY** – if you don't end up making a profit it's not a big deal! The camps cost \$170 + tax, which include all the meals, snacks, materials, field trips, transportation, and a camp T-shirt. The camp will be offered in English and in French.
